REOPENING GUIDELINES & TEMPLATES

The Governor's office has released guidelines and business safety templates for industries allowed to begin reopening in phase one. ALTHOUGH Western New York (which covers our counties of Cattaraugus and Allegany) are not reopening May 15th, we encourage those businesses classified in Phase One review the guidelines below as well as take the template and start completing it. **GOACC encourages ALL BUSINESS types to take the template and begin filling it out. That way all are prepped and ready to go once you get the green light.**

Business owners must read the "Detailed Guidelines" for their industries and provide their digital signature affirming they have read and understand the document. **PHASE ONE** businesses include: Construction; Retail Trade; Manufacturing; Agriculture, forestry, Fishing & Hunting; and Wholesale.

Dear Chamber Members...

GOACC's office has begun the template for reopening. Although we are essential and have limited staff in the office M-F from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., we are in Phase 2 for reopening the office.

The template is a useful tool to get your business in order. Each re-opening business must develop a written Safety Plan outlining how its workplace will prevent the spread of COVID-19.

This plan does not need to be submitted to a state agency for approval but must be retained on the premises of the business and must be made available to the New York State Department of Health (DOH) or local health or safety authorities in the event of an inspection.
