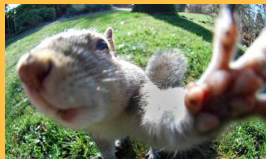

## OVERVIEW for Handling STAFF who test positive for Covid

**OVERVIEW for handling** both asymptomatic and symptomatic staff who test positive for Covid. These summary and examples of the return to work guidelines per NYSDOH are specific for health care workers, but is really generalizable to all.

The CDC recommends even if you test negative for COVID-19 or feel healthy, you should stay home

(quarantine) for 14 days from the last contact with a COVID-19 positive person since symptoms may appear 2 to 14 days after exposure to the virus. Below are two examples...

**Example of RN#A:** A Healthcare worker who is asymptomatic and has been tested and found to be positive will maintain isolation for 10 days after the date of the positive test.

- RN#A tests positive on 10/3/20
- RN#A will be taken off the schedule on 10/3/20, the county will put RN#A under mandatory quarantine and she remains isolated at home.
- As long as RN#A remains asymptomatic once the 10 days is up, RN#A can return to work on 10/13/20.
- If RN#A become symptomatic on 10/6/20 RN#A must remain isolated for 10 days from symptom onset.
- The new return to work date would be 10/16/20 as long as RN#A has been fever-free for 72 hours without fever reducing medication and with other symptoms improving.

**Example of RN#B:** A Healthcare worker who is symptomatic and has been tested and found to be positive will maintain isolation for 10 days from symptom onset.

- RN#B become symptomatic with fever, chills, cough on 10/3/20.
- RN#B self isolates at home, notifies manager/MHO and will be referred or testing by employee health.
- RN#B tests positive on 10/5/20.
- The county will put RN #B under mandatory quarantine for 10 days from symptom onset.
- RN #B remains isolated for 10 days from 10/3/20.
- RN#B may return to work on 10/13/20 as long as RN#B has been fever-free for 72 hours without fever reducing medication and with other symptoms improving.
