*SPOTLIGHT NEWS — UNION AND STATE DETOUR STARTS TODAY! *NEXT CyberNews out August 22, 2016

SPOTLIGHT EVENT —AUGUST 8 — UNION and STATE DETOUR. Starting today, August 8, 2016, the downtown work zone will include theentire intersection of North Union Street and State Street for the construction of the new roundabout, requiring traffic to detour around this area. Work willalso continue on the west side of North Union Street between Hamilton Streetand State Street.

CATCO will construct the roundabout and splitter islands atthe State Street intersection. Curb and streetscape work will continue on thewest side of North Union Street. Noparking will be permitted on the west side of North Union Street. Diagonal parking will be allowed wherepossible on the east side of North Union Street between Hamilton Street and therailroad.

Additional public parking is available on North 1st Streetand North Barry Street. Access to the Post Office will be provided on WestState Street. Detour routes usingLaurens Street, First Street, Henley Street, South Street, Barry Street andHamilton Street will be in place to allow the State Street roundabout to beconstructed.

ALSO, please watch, as there is a new stop sign for bothnorthbound and southbound traffic on South Barry Street at South Street.


