Below is information and listings of community resources for member businesses/ organizations and your employees. We encourage you to read through this email.



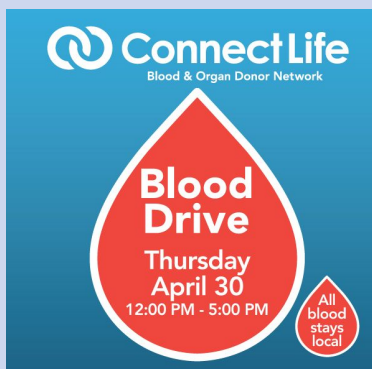

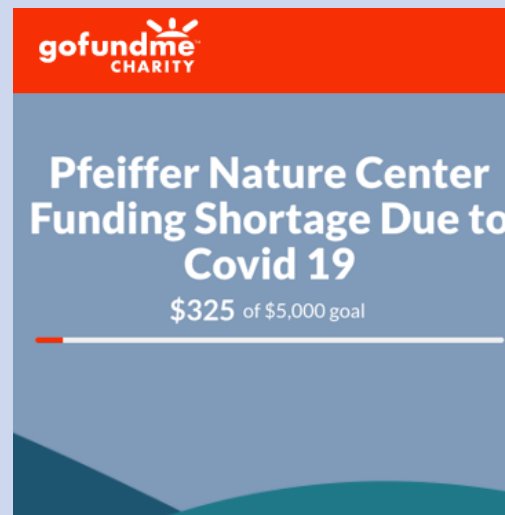
