BEFORE re-opening your doors in any phase, your business needs to go through the Phase and Category of your type of business guidelines. Read over those and then at the bottom ONLINE, you will need to click a button to affirm that you have done the template and other steps.

Your business also has to fill out a safety plan template and complete the items requested for in your business to protect your staff, your customers and the building. This needs to be filled out and then just kept at the business within reach if requested for review by NYS or County Health Departments - no need to turn this in to any one.

TEMPLATE

Each re-opening business must develop a written Safety Plan outlining how its workplace will prevent the spread of COVID-19. A business may **fill out this template to fulfill the requirement,** or may develop its own Safety Plan. This plan does not need to be submitted to a state agency for approval but must be retained on the premises of the business.
