largest exposure of quartz conglomerate (also called ocean spar or puddingstone) and attracts thousands of visitors yearly. Located on top of Rock City Hill, on route 16, south of Olean, New York. Its altitude is 2,300 feet above sea level. Walk among nature's creations and marvel at the rock formations!
